Update from T1

Friday, 7 December 2007 (00h39)

Race update from Transition 1, end of the 94km bike leg.

The following are the departure times for teams leaving for the 46km trekking leg:

- 1st - Salomon Navigator (Poland) - 18h23
- 2nd - Alpine Pro / Nutrend / Merida (Czech Republic) - 18h30
- 3rd - Master Unit (Finland) - 18h50
- 4th - Teva / La Pinilla (Spain) - 19h02
- 5th - Tilak / OpavaNet / Merida (Czech Republic) - 19h09
- 6th - Oure (Denmark) - 19h40

At 19h20 (GMT), Lima Salomon adventureteam.si (Slovenia) were about to leave transition.

Team MilleniumBCP3 (Portugal), Motorola SOS Mata Atlantica (Brazil) and Arena (Russia) had all arrived at 19h20 and were in transition.

It appears that both Motorola and Lima Salomon had encountered navigational problems late in the mountain biking stage. Arena appeared to have a clean ride over this section, closing at least one hour on Motorola.
